Dear Parent / Guardian:

Project Youth is a licensed after school program that is available to students at Brown, Hillside and Junior High Schools in Berlin (grades K-8) and Gorham Middle/High School students (Grades 6-8) in Gorham.

The program provides socializing and snack time, homework assistance, enrichment activities such as cooking, art, drama, games, physical activities, technology and computer time. Teachers report that most students participating in these after school programs have improved their reading and math grades, turn in more complete homework assignments and have a more positive attitude towards school.

The programs charge a small fee for participation; please see our sliding fee scale to determine your fee.

- The Berlin programs run Monday through Friday after school day dismissal.
- The Gorham program runs Monday through Friday, from 2:15 to 4:15 pm.
- Classroom teachers are available to help with homework and many of the enrichment activities.

If you would like to enroll your child in the Project Youth Afterschool Program you must submit the following:

- A completed Project Youth enrollment packet **with a copy of your child's most recent health and immunization record** from his/her physician attached.
- A Project Youth Fee Information Form (enclosed in packet).
- \$10.00 registration fee (\$15.00 for a family of two or more). Checks can be made payable to the Family Resource Center.

Completed forms can be returned to the Afterschool Program Coordinator at your child's school or the Project Youth Office at The Family Resource Center in Gorham.
